AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES

We have audited the annexed receipt and payment account of **Diya Pakistan (formerly Kaneez Fatima Welfare Foundation)** ("the Foundation") for the year ended 30 June 2011 together with the notes forming part thereof (here-in-after referred to as "the account") for the year then ended.

Notes to the Account

For the year ended 30 June 2011

1 NATURE OF ACTIVITIES

Diya Pakistan (formerly Kaneez Fatima Welfare Foundation) ("the Foundation") was registered under the Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registration and Control) Ordinance, 1961 on April 19, 1992. Its objectives are to provide financial assistance to the students in completing their education, and to assist the widows and the poor in satiating their daily livelihood. During the year the Foundation was also involved in flood relief activities. With effect from 2 October 2007 the activities are being carried out in the name of Diya Pakistan.

2 BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The receipt and payment account ("the account") has been prepared on cash receipt and payment basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. Revenue is recognized when the amount is received and expenses both revenue and capital expenses are recorded when paid.

3 FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSLATION

Donations received and funds withdrawn from bank accounts in foreign currency are recorded in Pak Rupees at the rates of exchange which approximate those prevailing at the date of the receipt of donation. Cash and bank balances held in foreign currencies are translated in Pak Rupees at the rates of exchange which approximate those prevailing at the reporting date. The resulting exchange gain or loss is taken into receipts or payments currently.

5 FLOOD RELIEF DONATIONS

This includes donations amounting to Rs. 6,429,843 received in the form of water filters.

6 ENDOWMENT FUND

An Endowment Fund has been created as per the instructions of the donor/ Board member. This fund is a restricted fund, not available for current operations of the Foundation.

7 DONATIONS - GENERAL

From 1st July 2009, all administrative expenses are borne by one of the founder members. All other donations including the balance left over after meeting the administrative expenses out of the funds received from founder member will be used specifically for stipend disbursements and included in Donations-flood relief. Total expenses borne by the founder member during the year were Rs. 2,916,924.

B EDUCATIONAL STIPEND

Educational stipend represents disbursements to students at school and inter level. At School level, total of 8,371 stipends were disbursed among students of 330 schools. At Inter level, 62 colleges were covered disbursing stipends to 1,440 students.

9 EDUCATIONAL STIPEND AS QARZ-E-HASNA

At University level, 1,120 stipends were disbursed to a total of 1,066 beneficiaries throughout Pakistan. All such amounts are expensed on disbursement. If any of these amounts are received at a future date, these will be treated as donations received.

10 BACK TO SCHOOL PROGRAM

In-kind stipends were distributed among 86,105 students enrolled in 462 flood affected schools. Each package consisted of school bag, notebooks and stationery materials. The project is financed by EY-DIYA Flood Rehabilitation Program.

11 FLOOD SCHOLARSHIPS

Educational stipends in flood affected areas were awarded to 46 school students, 2,468 Inter-level students and 462 University-level students. The project is financed by EY-DIYA Flood Rehabilitation Program.

12 EY-DIYA PUR HOUSING PROJECT

The project comprises construction of 49 shelter complex in Tehsil Tangi, District Charsadda for flood affected families. This also includes cost of the Foundation's share in procurement of land. The project is financed by EY-DIYA Flood Rehabilitation Program.

13 EY-DIYA MODEL VILLAGE PROJECT

The project comprises construction of 100 shelter complex in village Jatti, District Thatta for flood affected families. The project is financed by EY-DIYA Flood Rehabilitation Program.
