We have audited the annexed receipt and payment account of Diya Pakistan ("the Foundation") for the year ended 30 June 2013 together with the notes forming part thereof (here-in-after referred to as "the account") for the year then ended.

Notes to the Account

For the year ended 30 June 2013

1 NATURE OF ACTIVITIES

DIYA Pakistan (formerly Kaneez Fatima Welfare Foundation) ("the Foundation") was registered under the Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registration and Control) Ordinance, 1961 on April 19, 1992. Its objective is to provide financial assistance to the deserving students throught Pakistan in completing their education and/or vocational training. During the year Foundation was also involved in flood relief & rehabilitation activities.

2 BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The receipt and payment account ("the account") has been prepared on cash receipt and payment basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. Revenue is recognized when the amount is received and expenses both revenue and capital expenses are recorded when paid.

3 FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSLATION

Donations received in foreign currencies are recorded in Pak Rupees at the rate of exchange prevailing at the dates of receipts of funds. Funds drawn from bank accounts in foreign currency are recorded in Pak Rs. at the rates at which they are converted. Cash and bank balances held in foreign currencies are translated in Pak Rupees at the rates of exchange which approximate those prevailing at the reporting date. The resulting exchange gain or loss is taken into receipts or expenditure currently.

5 DONATIONS - EDUCATION

During the year the Foundation received as donation a plot of 1000 square yards located in the Supreme Court Employees Cooperative Housing Society, Islamabad. This plot is included at nominal value.

This includes Rs. 4,685,000 (2012: Nil) received for support of specified students till completion of their graduation. Payments will start in following year.

6 DONATIONS - ENDOWMENT FUND

A donation of Rs. 500,000 has been received during the current year which will be invested in a Islamic investment scheme. Scholarship from the proceeds of the investment will be granted to a specified eligible student. The remaining endowment fund of Rs. 2,725,000 is available to meet any shortfall in future years.

7 REIMBURSEMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

From 1st July 2009, all administrative expenses are borne by the founder members. All other donations including the balance left over after meeting the administrative expenses out of the funds received from founder members will be used specifically for stipend disbursements. Total administrative expenses for the year amounted to Rs. 3,428,080 (2012: Rs. 3,360,655).

8 EDUCATIONAL STIPEND

Educational stipend represents disbursements to students at school and technical level. At School level, a total of 12,681 stipends (2012: 13,428) were disbursed among students of 455 institutes (2012: 533). At Technical level, which has been initiated during this fiscal year, 20 institutes were covered disbursing stipends to 1,008 students.

EDUCATIONAL STIPEND - UNIVERSITY LEVEL

At University level, 1,450 beneficiaries were awarded educational stipends (2012: 1,390 stipends) throughout Pakistan.

10 SINDH HOUSING PROJECT - DIGRI

The project comprised of construction of 50 shelters in Tehsil Digri, Sindh for flood affected families.
